Fifth Month 2019 Meeting for Worship for Business Summary

Continuing in worship, 18 Friends took up the business of London Grove Monthly Meeting. The Minutes of 4/7 were approved with a minor correction.

Recorder Betsy Walker regretfully reported the deaths of our members Allan S. Thomforde on 4/16 and Willard H. Smedley, Jr. on 4/30.

Treasurer Doug Myers shared the April Income and Expense reports. He noted that, 33% through the year, we have received 34% of budgeted contributions. Net income for the month was \$12,012.40.

Margaret Walton and Mark Myers reported on the 4/28 Western Quarterly Meeting, held jointly with Concord Quarter at Wilmington Friends School. Separate business sessions were held by each quarter. WQM's business session was well attended, and LGMM's "Minute Supporting the Prevention of Nuclear War" and last month's report on the 3/22 Interim Session of Philadelphia Yearly Meeting were referred to the other monthly meetings in our quarter for discernment. Fourteen children attended, ages between 2 and middle school. High School students came to the afternoon session about implicit bias, presented by Dr. Amanda Kemp of Lancaster Monthly Meeting. Mark reflected that Friends consciously hold a "rightly-ordered" view of the world; yet our racial bias is usually unconscious. To overcome implicit bias, we are called to let our conscious mind prevail. Robin DiAngelo's work on "white fragility" and Dr. Kemp's "5 Step" approach to address implicit bias have been found helpful.

Carolyn Muller presented the Annual Report of the In-Reach Committee. The committee continues to work with the RE Committee toward assuring that caregivers are available for children at LGMM while adults participate in meeting for worship and Adult RE. The all-electronic distribution of the Christmas Newsletter has saved money; this year we were pleased to hire Claire Taylor Brandenburg to work with children on 2nd First Days. We will be challenged to help some caregivers update their clearances when they expire in 2020.

Charlie Brosius gave an update from the Burial Grounds Committee, after acknowledging the recent loss of committee member Willard "Chip" Smedley. The work begun in 2015 to repoint the north and south stone walls and repair the Black Walnut root-displacement of a corner of the tool shed is nearly completed. Charlie complimented the Recording Secretary on her excellent summary of last month's Annual Report from the Burial Grounds Committee.
